Mr. Pemberton:

The WindandTide Community Association, which is a party of record in the above matter, was encouraged to hear about the County's decision to issue a Determination of Significance (DS) in accordance with the State Environmental Policy Act. However, the DS addresses only one issue: grading of the steeply sloped area in the planned development. Although this is a very significant issue, it does not include the added traffic generated by this high-density development (116 lots on 21.4 acres) nor does it address the impacts on public services and utilities. In addition, it does not deal with the impacts from the clear-cutting of 19 acres of the 21.4-acre development on the adjoining residential areas, protected areas and Picnic Point Creek.

We again appeal to your sense of responsibility and request that you require a complete Environmental Impact Statement from the developer so that all the issues stated above will be examined and resolved according to the State Environmental Policy Act.
